Springs Soccer Club 2024-2025 Tryout Basics

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TRYOUTS

THE BASICS

What to bring:

Players should bring a ball, water, cleats, shin guards, and a great attitude.

What to wear:

Players should not wear any of their club uniforms and instead, wear a white shirt. If they do not have a white shirt any color will be acceptable.

Time:

Please arrive about 45 minutes before your tryout time.

Early arrival will ensure you have enough time to get checked in, receive your tryout number, and stretch before the tryout begins. You will wear your same tryout number for each session. That number will be how the coaches identify you. It should be pinned onto the right side of the players shorts.

Where:

You will check in at your assigned field per the tryout schedule.

Goalkeepers will check-in at their assigned field for their age group. The coach will then instruct them either to go with the keeper coach or stay with the age group.

When:

The tryouts schedule is posted on our website. Players are encouraged to attend every session but if that is an impossibility please talk to the coach when you arrive at the field.

Rain:

Field closures will be noted on our website and social media, please follow our social media to get updates.

Where do parents watch:

Please refrain from entering the field or talking to the coaches.

We ask that after the player has been checked in that the parents either utilize the walking paths or return to the parking lots.

Team Selection:

Our Goal is to pick most of first team (Elite) roster the first day of tryouts so that our second (Phantom) and third (Tiempo/Legend) team coaches can focus on selections the second day. Parents, please be patient during this process as we sometimes may have a delay, especially with age groups that have large numbers. Some of our coaches may need more time to look at the players and choose their teams which may even lead for an extra day of tryouts.

What happens once my player is chosen?

You will receive a welcome email with your team placement.

The welcome email will have a registration link with your invitation to accept the position and register. Once you receive the invitation you will have 24 hours to accept the spot on the team.
